Winter Adventure Package Contest Official Rules and Regulations

These are the official rules and regulations governing the 'Winter Adventure Package' Contest.

1. The 'Winter Adventure Package' Contest (the "Contest"), sponsored by Destination Cape Breton and TNT Outdoor Adventures, commences at 12:00 am AST on October 25, 2024 and concludes at 4:00 pm AST on November 1st, 2024 (the "Contest Entry Period").

2. How to Enter:

- a. Participants must scan the QR Code provided at The Toronto International Snowmobile, ATV & Powersports Show.
- b. After scanning the QR Code, participants will be prompted to enter their information in the entry form provided.
- c. No purchase is necessary to enter. Entries must be submitted during the Contest Entry Period. All entries ("Entries" or an "Entry") become the property of the Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned.
- 3. The Contest is open to all residents (excluding areas where prohibited by law) who are 21 years of age or older at the time of entry, except employees of Destination Cape Breton, TNT Outdoor Adventures or its affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising or promotional agencies, or immediate family members of such employees (defined as parents, siblings, children, and spouses, regardless of where they live), or anyone who is domiciled with such employees. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited.

 - A snowmobile tour with TNT Outdoor Adventures

All taxes and accommodation levy fees are included (gratuities not included). Any additional costs and/or fees incurred by the winner and/or the accompanying traveler are the sole responsibility of the winner and/or accompanying traveler. The prize is based on availability at the time of booking.

- 8. A random, electronic draw will be made by a Destination Cape Breton employee in Sydney, Nova Scotia, on November 8, 2024 at 4:00 pm AST from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received.
- 9. The Sponsor will attempt to contact the winner via phone for approximately two (2) weeks following the selection process, between 9:00 am Atlantic and 8:00 pm Atlantic. If the Sponsor is unable to make contact with the selected winner after five (5) attempts, the winner will be disqualified, and another winner will be chosen from the remaining eligible entries.
- 10. To win the prize, the selected winner must meet all the following conditions:
 - a. Provide proof of identification;
 - b. Sign and return the Contest Winner Form, declaring acceptance of the prize and all related terms. The signed Form must be returned to the Sponsor within seven (7) days from the date it is sent;
 - c. Comply with these Official Contest Rules. Failure to meet any of these conditions will result in disqualification, and the prize will be forfeited.
- 11. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees that the Sponsor may use their name, city of residence, and/or photograph for promotional purposes without compensation.

The Sponsor and each of its respective affiliated and associated persons and entities, are not responsible or liable, jointly or severally, for any of the following: erroneous, damaged, destroyed, lost, late, incomplete, illegible, incorrectly addressed, or misdirected entries, regardless of the cause; failure for any reason whatsoever of selected entrants to receive notification of prize package; or malfunctions or errors that may occur, regardless of the cause. 15.
